

The Senior Cycle Redevelopment Programme Management Office are analysing feedback received through mentimeter on the day, as well as the post-event survey.














































Supports for teachers and school leaders on the use of Al

Oide provides comprehensive support for teachers and school leaders on the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI), particularly Generative AI (Gen AI) in education. A dedicated webpage, <u>Artificial Intelligence in Schools</u>, provides access to resources including an introductory online course, "AI for Schools." This course helps educators understand AI, highlighting key policy documents and ethical considerations as outlined in the Digital Strategy for Schools to 2027.

Oide resources also include:

- Bespoke school support, where a digital technologies team
 professional learning leader provides support tailored to the specific
 needs of each school, focusing on the use of AI in learning, teaching,
 and assessment,
- Al for Schools Video Series, a series of interviews with experts on the topic of Al in the Irish and European education context.
- The <u>Webwise Al Hub</u> for online safety, provides information and resources on artificial intelligence and how it can benefit and support users, as well the current limitations and concerns about its use.
- The Webwise AUP Generator has been recently updated, providing 21 statements that guide appropriate use of AI tools in your school.
- Artificial Intelligence: Five Considerations for Teacher Use
 Infographic. A concise guide to support responsible, effective, and inclusive integration of AI into teachers' practice.
- The RASE Prompt Framework for Implementing Al in Teaching. A
 practical resource designed to help educators craft clear, effective
 prompts for interacting with GenAl tools.

These resources are designed to equip educators with the knowledge to utilise AI effectively and ethically in their professional environments.

Coming soon: April 2025

Four sample examination papers - two Higher Level and two Ordinary Level - for each subject in Tranche 1 will issue to schools. This is a total of 36 sample papers across the nine subjects—72 papers in total when Irish Versions are included. The papers will include guidance on the mark allocations.

September 2025

Specifications in new and revised subjects introduced in schools. A sample brief for the AAC in each subject will be in schools at the same time.

January 2026

A live brief for AACs for all subjects will be issued.




